

## **Gamble Township Supervisors**

**May 11, 2021**

The Gamble Township Supervisors met on the above date for their regular meeting at the Community Hall, Calvert, beginning at 7:30 PM, with 2 members present. Steve Brady, Dave Bailey, with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Steve made a motion, seconded by Dave, to accept the April minutes.

Dave made a motion, seconded by Steve, to accept the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.

Do to the absence of Joe, the Board will review the auditor's report next month. Dave had reviewed the report and presented his comments to the Auditors and Board. See attached.

The Secretary presented several items of correspondence.

Zoning: 5 permits were issued. County had sent a letter to resident of Butternut Grove for not getting a permit.

Planning: Aikey subdivision was approved and there is to be a Zoning Ordinance Amendment hearing on June 15.

EMA: Nothing. Joe suggested Justin McCoy consider this position, due to his position as road master.

Road Master: Justin had several items to present to the Board. 1. PJ Electric bid for electrical work at both the Community Hall and Maintenance shed. Community Hall - \$2708.00 and the shed - \$5455.00 for a total of \$8163.00. Steve made a motion, seconded by Dave, to accept. Motion carried. 2. Maintenance shed/equipment – Backhoe- Warner's to look at and give estimate; skid steer-repairs just done; had gotten 3 bids for a new storage facility for materials: Big Rock Paving - \$10,200; M&M Paving - \$10,427; All Excavating - \$10,900; this would be a 25x100 ft paved area with 6 bins to store the stone and salt. Blocks to make the bins – Big Rock - \$6725.00, only bid. By the end of August or Sept, would need a roof over the anti skid and salt bins. Also could get a fire company to wash out the shed, which would be just for parking the equipment. Dave made a motion, seconded by Steve, to accept the bid from Big Rock Paving for the lot. Dave made a motion, seconded by Steve, to accept the bid from Big Rock for the purchase of the blocks. Both motions carried. 3. 2017 truck in garage now. This will be the second transmission since vehicle was purchased in early 2018. Not sure if it can be rebuilt or put a new one in. 4. Justin had applications from 2 people for new employees. Board met in Executive session after the meeting to discuss. Justin would like to have at least 4 employees on call.

On-Going: 1. Nothing new 2. Still a work in progress 3. Nothing 4. Ambulance service- Eldred Twp has ambulance out of service, not sure what is going on with this.

5. Bids: See attached. Steve made a motion, seconded by Dave, to accept the bid from Hanson for aggregates and the bid from Hei-Way for cold patch material. Motion carried. 6. CD was taken care of. 7. Dave made a motion, seconded by Steve, for secretary to send thank you letter to Penn Dot regarding decision to make a run-around on Wallis Run Rd at the bridge project.

New: 1. Township crew cleaned up the trash along Lake Road

2. Dave made a motion, seconded to Steve, to approve the Hazard Mitigation resolution.

3. Justin would like to have a dumpster at the maintenance shed, also a restroom there. Tabled until next month.

Public Comment: Dave Albert thought that new lights at the Community Hall is a good idea.

Dave made a motion, seconded by Steve, to pay the bills.

Meeting adjourned at 9:15 PM. , followed by Executive Session.
