

Gamble Township Supervisors

September 14, 2021

The Gamble Township Supervisors met on the above date for their regular meeting at the Community Hall, Calvert, beginning at 7:30 PM, with 3 members present. Joe Reighard, Dave Bailey, Steve Brady, with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Steve made a motion, seconded by Dave, to accept the August minutes and treasurer's reports as presented. Motion carried.

Gregg Saunders and Joe Zoke, with Inflection Energy, presented proposal for repairs to Caleb Creek Rd from Pleasant Valley to Reynolds gas pad. This would be a full depth reclamation with a 3" asphalt binder course. This would leave a 450 Ft section between this and what was just done near Rider Park. Inflection is willing to work with the township in regard to this and any pipe replacements. Dave made a motion, seconded by Joe, for preliminary approval of this work. Inflection also has to meet with Eldred Township too.

Correspondence – several items were presented.

Zoning: 1 permit was issued.

Planning: Nothing

EMA: Quarterly newsletter from County

Road Master: 1. Dubois Hollow – udrain exposed, roadway not hurt, just ditch. Should put in concrete inlets which township crew could do. Joe would prefer having an engineer look at this. 2. Murray Run – problems with driveways at top, near Todd Jean. Joe will contact Todd to discuss this. 3. Both trucks to go to garage for recalls. 2014 – just inspected and hub fixed. 2017 – needs repairs to rear end where damaged last winter, cost of \$850. Justin to take care of this. 4. Proposal for salt shed of \$28,500. To be put on agenda for next month. 5. Logue Hill and Murray Run—finished. 6. Well – company waiting to get paid before finishing. 7. Justin would like a steam jenny – tabled until next month, put on agenda. 8. Would like to dispose of 2 fuel tanks, put on MuniciBid. 9. Dumpster and electric work done.

On-Going: 1. ROW acquisition on Winner Lane – Joe will set up a meeting with property owner. 2. Web site – agenda will be posted 24 hours before meeting and will also be posted at hall. 3. Nothing new. 4. Nothing new on ambulance service. 5. Letter from Solicitor should take care of this. 6. Furnace to be installed starting Sept 15. 7. Board signed letters for Warner Tractor in regard to new backhoe.

New: 1. Sec to check at to what was decided in regard to hiring of new personnel, whether road master or Board to set wages.

Public Comment: 1. Dave Albert – wanted to know how roads would be taken care of during the week this winter if maintenance work is being done only on weekends. Also, he had not received anything about the bridge work. 2. Betty wanted to know why the outside light at the front of the hall is on all the time. Justin thinks there is something wrong with the switch. 3. Chelsey had several questions: a. who is the zoning officer . b. where to get 911 reflective signs. C. would the township buy a ‘no outlet’ sign for her drive, which is a private road. She would have to get this. D. Is township aware of damage that PGE did to road way. Justin is to look at this.

Dave made a motion, seconded by Steve, to pay the bills.
