Minutes
February 8, 2022**

Roadmaster: 1. Salt shed is completed. 2. Roads- having an issue with people pushing snow onto the township roads. Decided to put something on the website to remind people that this is illegal. 3. 2017 truck is at Watson's to have new plow installed. 4. Roads – still a few that are snow-covered due to weather. 5. Salt – not having any trouble getting as some municipalities are, we are using CoStars, others are under a COG. 6. Anti Skid – is there a limit on how much we can purchase – No.

On-Going: 1. Bridge Bundling – Joe met with property owner and came to an agreement. Solicitor writing up agreement for Board. \$500 for construction of easement plus several loads of stone for owner's parking area. 2. Fish/Boat Commission/ Lake – Nothing new, will look at problem areas when doing road tour. 3. Solicitor /ordinance – Joe will check with County to see if this is covered by County ordinance. 4. Road workers' wages – not set at organizational meeting so Steve made a motion, seconded by Joe, as to increases. See attached. Sec to check wages for last 4 years for next meeting.

New Business: 1. ARP training for secretary—not needed. 2. Salt Contract for 2022-23: increase to 250 T. 3. Snow Plow – purchased from Watson at a cost of \$5553.00.
4. ARP funds – just expend all on report as there are many different uses now.

Public Comment: Dave Albert expresses appreciation for the way the roads have been taken care of this winter.

Payment of bills: Steve made a motion, seconded by Dave, to pay the bills.
