

**Gamble Township Minutes**  
**April 12, 2022**

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM with 2 members present, with the Pledge of Allegiance. Members present were: Joe Reighard and Dave Bailey. Steve arrived a few minutes late.

Dave made a motion , seconded by Steve, to approve the March minutes and Treasurer's reports.

Guests present were: 1.Bo Lewis, a student from Penn College, gave a presentation on his senior project which was to design some improvements to Rose Valley Lake at the South end, at the beaver dam.

Secretary presented several items of correspondence, including the township spring meeting and a grant writing workshop at Penn college. There was also one gas company.

Aggregates: Dave made a motion, seconded by Steve, for 2A, #57, R-3, R-6, R-8 from GOH; Joe abstained; 3. R-4 and AntiSkid – Hanson Aggregates – Steve made a motion, seconded by Dave, all in favor. 4. Fuel – Dave made a motion, seconded by Steve to go with Reeder Bros. 6. Road tour – covered under roadmaster.

New Business: 1. Fuel tanks – had been advertised on Muncibid; 1. 225 gal tank/hand crank - \$852.00; 2. 200 gal tank - \$400.00 Steve made a motion, seconded by Dave to accept these bids. Joe will contact the bidders and arrange for pick up.

Public Comment: 1. Ginny Stroble – pipes along sugar Camp Road all need cleaned out. 2. Auditors – when to do inventory at township shed – told to pick 2 dates and contact Justin. 3. Jack Hipple- wanted to know when township was going to fix his drive where roadmaster had gotten stuck this past winter and also when the ditch across the field behind the maintenance shed would be taken care of. Was told this seemed to be a miscommunication as township will take care of when the weather permits. Open ditch at the township shed (when well was drilled) Justin to take care of ASAP.

Payment of bills: Joe made a motion, seconded by Dave, to pay the bills.
