

Gamble Township Minutes August 9, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM with 3 members present, with the Pledge of Allegiance. Members present were: Dave Bailey, Steve Brady, Joe Reighard.

Steve made a motion , seconded by Dave, to approve the July minutes and Treasurer's reports.

Guests: Matt Henderson, PGE, gave an update on project along Loyalsock Ck at end of Butternut Grove Rd, regarding the gas pipeline.

Secretary presented several items of correspondence regarding updates on various road projects in the area and a bridge replacement on Wallis Run Road.

Zoning: Regarding the hearing for the Andrews' property, PennDot says location is okay, the stand can't be moved back because of septic drainfield. County approved the location.

Planning: County Planning Commission had discussed airbnbs, particularly in the Pine Creek area, regulations are in place, they just need to be enforced.

EMA: Justin is trying to get Joe Colucci back as township EMA coordinator.

Roadmaster: 1. In regard to Caleb Creek, any information needed as to roadway is available from Lycoming County. 2. Murray Run Rd – done, except for paving. 3. Dubois Hollow, Calvert Rd and twp. Building – not done yet. 4. Had received a call regarding a tree hanging over Calvert Road, near Schriners, will keep an eye on it for now. 5. Mowing along Caleb Creek, Justin not sure who was to do this. 6. Joe had received a call from Mark Ranck, that Inflection will be paving all of Chaapel Mt. Road. 7. In talking with other townships, who should be setting the wage for Dave Bailey, as a roadworker. He is a Supervisor, so the pay rate has to be set by the Auditors.

On-Going: 1. Fish/Boat Commission/ Lake – we have heard nothing from the Fish Commission regarding Lake Road. Some discussion ensued as to the parking area along Lake Road, across from Brady's driveway, as to people parking there and tearing up the area. A motion was made to set up blocks on township row, as a cost of approx.. \$3500. Motion carried, but was soon rescinded. Will look at doing something when Lake Road work is done. 2. Solicitor has not gotten back to us regarding ordinance. 3. Joe sent the solicitor copies of the 2 EMS agreements for review, with a deadline of Aug 20 to hear back. Board then will review and discuss at Sept. meeting. Dave asked Secretary to get a report from County as to the # of calls in Gamble Township.

New Business: 1. Date change for November meeting due to Election. Will hold Township meeting on Wednesday, Nov 9.

Public Comment: 1. Questioned why money is spent for 'No Maintenance' signs- mandated by state to put up these signs.

Payment of bills: Joe made a motion, seconded by Steve, to pay the bills.
