

**Gamble Township  
Minutes  
February 13, 2023**

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM with 3 members present, with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Members present were: Joe Reighard, Steve Brady, Dave Bailey.

Steve made a motion, seconded by Dave, to approve the January minutes and the Treasurer's reports as presented. Motion carried.

There were four members of the Fire Company to present their yearly report of fire and ambulance calls and what is happening with the consolidation of the neighboring fire companies. They are now called the North Lycoming Fire, Rescue & EMS – Station 48, which is a combination of Hepburn, Trout Run and Ralston fire companies, covering Hepburn, Lycoming, Lewis, Gamble, Cascade, Macintyre, and Cogan House Townships. They had paid EMTs on call 24/7 consisting of 3 full time and 3 part time EMTs. Gamble Twp is still considering funds for the combined fire/EMS service.

Secretary presented several items of correspondence, including Conservation Dirt/Gravel program, bidding thresholds and various gas companies.

Zoning: quarterly report and 2 permits

Planning: Nothing

Roadmaster: 1. Mud/debris on the roadways – Roadmaster should contact property owner to clean off. 2. Flag is up. 3. Trees along the roadway – would like to have cut down, roadmaster to see if contractor would give a daily rate for this work for this time of year. 4. Fish commission had contacted Justin regarding some signs that were posted along Lake Rd. Nothing Twp can do as they are not on township right of way. 5. Post pounder – told to see Bradco Supply about one. 6. Truck – not an issue right now.

On-Going: 1. EMS agreement –thoroughly discussed at beginning of meeting. 2.. Lake Rd bridge postings – need post pounder to put in. 3. Winner Lane – pipe not taken care of yet.

New: 1 Salt contract for 2023-24 – same amount as previous year.

2. Justin would like to pave in front of maintenance shed from building to road.

3. Justin would like to remove the old shed as it is not being used. Joe is against removing this shed. Could still be used for storage.

Payment of bills: Dave made a motion, seconded by Joe, to pay the bills.
