

**Gamble Township  
Minutes  
August 14, 2023**

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM with 3 members present, with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Members present were: Steve Brady, Dave Bailey, Joe Reighard

Dave made a motion, seconded by Steve, to approve the July minutes and the August Treasurer's reports as presented. Motion carried.

Guests: 1. Matt Henderson, PGE, stated that Butternut Grove Road work was taken care of.

Several items of correspondence was presented, including an offer from REC regarding the closing of the one account that the township had. Joe made a motion, seconded by Steve, to accept their offer of \$473.65 to close the account. Motion carried with one opposition.

Zoning: 1 permit was issued.

Planning: Nothing

EMA: Nothing

Roadmaster: 1. Signage done on Lake Road; 2. Really need to buy something to install posts. Joe will check on something. 3. Still working on mowing. 4. Would like to spray around bridges, etc. Would need someone with a pesticide permit to do this. 5. Paving to begin Aug 25 at maintenance shed; then Winner Lane on Aug 30; Dubois Hollow, Aug 31; Butternut Grove – Sept 5&6, which will not be closed completely, will be doing one lane at a time. 6. Truck – 2017 needs work done again on transmission (3<sup>rd</sup> time). Joe will call Fairfield regarding this. Justin feels that a new truck is really needed and keep the 2017 as a backup. 7. Need to get an answering machine for shed. 8. Butternut Grove Road – ditches fixed by PGE. 9. Resident asked about Mill Ck Rd – washout just past Dan Easton's. Justin to check on this.

On-Going: 1. EMS agreement – Secretary to prepare letter to fire companies, asking for clarification on their requests. There was some discussion as to what is a fair donation to the fire companies. This should be based on per capita, not just what they feel is a fair amount, there should be equality between the various townships involved.

New: 1. Joe made a motion, seconded by Dave, to invest \$1.2million of the Act 13 funds in an 11-month CD at Muncy Bank at a rate of 5.25%. All in favor.

Public Comment: Donna S – no center line on Sugar Camp Road. Needs to be repainted. Will look into this

Payment of bills: Dave made a motion, seconded by Joe, to pay the bills.
