

**GAMBLE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES – DECEMBER 16, 2024**

The Gamble Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting at the Gamble Township Community Hall, Trout Run, PA. Present were Supervisors Stephan Brady, David Bailey, Roadmaster Justin McCoy and Secretary Raine Ohnmeiss. Absent: Joseph Reighard
