

**GAMBLE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES – JULY 21, 2025**

The Gamble Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting at the Gamble Township Community Hall, Trout Run, PA. Present were Supervisors Stephan Brady, David Bailey, and Secretary Raine Ohnmeiss. Absent: Supervisor Joseph Reighard and Roadmaster Justin McCoy. The meeting was called to order by Stephan Brady at 7:30 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES/FINANCIAL

NEW BUSINESS/ACTION ITEMS

Dale Gower was in attendance to discuss allowing ATV/UTV's to utilize roads in Gamble Township legally. Neighboring Lewis Township approved the use. David Bailey stated this issue was brought before the board a couple of years ago. Curfews, road hunting and enforcement of the ordinance are concerns. Some residents may gain enjoyment from riding the ATV/UTV's, but others may not appreciate the noise and littering. Elwood Loudenslager stated the public should have a say during the election. The township will contact Lycoming County Voter Services to see if this is something that can be placed on the ballot. An example copy of the ordinance was requested to be given to the board and a copy will be sent to the township solicitor.

A motion was made by David Bailey, seconded by Stephan Brady and unanimously passed to open a \$900,000.00 certificate of deposit at 4.25% for 6 months with Journey Bank. The money marking checking at Jersey Shore State Bank will be closed and deposited into the checking account at Journey Bank.
