

**GAMBLE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES – NOVEMBER 17, 2025**

The Gamble Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting at the Gamble Township Community Hall, Trout Run, PA. Present were Supervisors Joseph Reighard, Stephan Brady, David Bailey, Roadmaster Justin McCoy and Secretary Raine Ohnmeiss. The meeting was called to order by Joseph Reighard at 7:30 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

**MINUTES/FINANCIAL**

A motion was made by David Bailey, seconded by Stephan Brady and unanimously passed approving the regular meeting minutes of October 20, 2025, and all the financial reports.

Mowing is done as the transmission is blown on the tractor. Issues on the Murray Run Bridge were discussed, Justin McCoy will request a bridge inspection report be sent to the Secretary.

Raine Ohnmeiss also received a call from Kinetic (former Windstream) asking the township required Highway Occupancy Permits (HOP)? Gamble Township does require HOP's, a standard HOP application will be mailed to them.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

Donna Schmouder asked if we ever spoke to the attorney about the ATV/UTV ordinance being on the ballot? The township consulted with the attorney and it cannot be placed on the ballot. Schmouder asked if the township would be liable if an accident occurred? It would be like any other vehicle on the road.

Ed West expressed concern about the new truck overheating, shouldn't it be taken back to the dealership before it is needed for snow? Justin McCoy stated it only happened that one time, he used it the other day with no issues. It was explained that when running the plow truck on a highway it is common for it to overheat; there is no reason to have it looked at.

Donna Schmouder stated office trailers are constantly being taken back to Compressor Road, are permits required? Joseph Reighard stated temporary structures do not require permits.

There being no further questions or comments, a motion was made by Stephan Brady, seconded by David Bailey and unanimously approved to adjourn the meeting at 8:24 p.m.
