

**GAMBLE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES – NOVEMBER 18, 2024 (CORRECTED)**

The Gamble Township Board of Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting at the Gamble Township Community Hall, Trout Run, PA. Present were Supervisors Joseph Reighard, Stephan Brady, David Bailey, Roadmaster Justin McCoy and Secretary Raine Ohnmeiss.

The meeting was called to order by Joseph Reighard at 7:30 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

**MINUTES**

A motion was made by David Bailey, seconded by Joseph Reighard and unanimously passed approving the regular meeting minutes of October 21, 2024.

**FINANCIAL**

ROADMASTER – Justin McCoy reported that weather permitting stone will be placed on Mill Creek next week. 3 quotes were provided for the placement of stone with a paver, the lowest quote was \$10,666.00, the township will purchase the stone. The Board reviewed the Proposed Budget. A motion was made by Stephan Brady, seconded by Dave Bailey to approve the proposed budget with an increase in Earned Income Tax and a decrease for In Lieu of Taxes.
